ORDER TO REVOKE USDOT NEW ENTRANT REGISTRATION AND CEASE ALL INTERSTATE TRANSPORTATION U.S. DOT Number: 1797308

This Order is issued pursuant to 49 CFR section 385.308(d). On December 22, 2011 CARLOS JOSE PEREZ LAGOS was served a Demand for Written Response which notified that its USDOT New Entrant registration would be revoked unless a written response was submitted within 30 days demonstrating corrective action. Because CARLOS JOSE PEREZ LAGOS has failed to submit a written response to the Demand CARLOS JOSE PEREZ LAGOS's USDOT New Entrant registration is hereby revoked, effective January 26, 2012. CARLOS JOSE PEREZ LAGOS must cease all interstate motor carrier operations in the United States.

Failure to comply with this Order may subject the carrier to penalty provisions in 49 USC 521(b)(2)(A) not to exceed \$11,000 for each offense.

Under section 49 CFR section 385.329(a), CARLOS JOSE PEREZ LAGOS may reapply for USDOT New Entrant registration no earlier than 30 days after the effective date of this revocation. CARLOS JOSE PEREZ LAGOS must submit an updated Motor Carrier Identification Report (MCS-150), and restart the 18-month new entrant monitoring period. Reapplication may be made via the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) web site (http://safer.fmcsa.dot.gov) or by submitting a MCS-150 form. The form may be obtained by calling FMCSA's technical support at 1-800-832-5660 or via the FMCSA web site.
